- Tour program **starts 8:00am - finish around 4:30** from Style Motorbikes (20 Hoang Huu Chuyen, Ha Giang City)
- A Group tour is a maximum of **8 guests** / Private tour no max or minimum.
- Prices and everything which is **included** and **excluded** (page 5).
- We do **NOT** share our routes, activities or accommodations.
- Mixed group tours are **3 or 4 days** - Private tours can be any number of days you want.
- All tours are available as **Easy Rider, Self Riding, by SUV or Jeep**.
- Each day involves around **4 hours** on the bike. (8 hour day).

The 3 day, 2 night tour

Whilst it is not possible to see the whole loop in just 3 days, we have crafted an itinerary designed to show you the best of the loop. In 3 days you'll see around 70% of the loop, some hidden gems, backroads and trails. Waterfalls, caves, swimming holes and remote highland villages.

Just some of the route highlights.....

Quan Ba, Tham Ma , Can Ty, Bac Sum & Chin Khoanh Passes - legendary mountain roads with incredible long distance views.

Pho Bang Ancient Town - A traditional ethnic village near the Chinese border, famed for its clay houses.

Lao Xa Silversmith Village - A very remote Hmong village high in the mountains, where life stands still.

Hmong King's Palace - 100 year old mansion of the former Hmong Royal family.

Deo Ma Pi Leng, Nho Que river and Tu San canyon - the most breathtaking views and surreal boat ride through the canyon.

Lung Tam Linen Cooperative - a traditional weaving workshop making clothing and goods from hemp.

Dong Van Karst Plateau - A Unesco geo-park, featuring unique rock formations





The 4 day, 3 night tour



Our 4 day tour covers everything on our 3 day, however, we take a totally different route.

The extra day means you'll see 100% of the loop and some!!!

The 4 day tour allows for a more complete experience; it allows us more time to take you further off the beaten track. Smaller, longer trails with even more hidden gems along the way.

Additional highlights.....

Anh Cuong Cave - A short trek into cool underground chambers with limestone formations.

North Dong Van Loop - Rice terraces, cliffside roads and long distance views into China.

Si Lau Phin Village - A rarely visited ethnic village, deep in the mountains, well away from civilisation.

Yenh Minh pine forests and town - Nestled on high ground, Yen Minh has a cool and relaxing vibe.

Lung Cu Flag Tower - Vietnam's most northern point, climb the tower for 360 views.

Lo Lo Chai Cultural Village - Home to the Lo Lo minority, a community of just 120 families.

Sao Ha - Deep valleys covered with shades of greens, layered mountain peaks and views for days!

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Easy Rider Option

This is the most popular way to experience The Loop.

You sit as passenger behind a qualified rider. You also get your own personal butler - they will help you with your luggage, take care of your helmet and make sure you are comfortable throughout the trip.

Ideal for anyone who isn't confident riding themselves or those that simply prefer to relax and enjoy the journey, you are free to enjoy 360-degree views without having to focus so much on the road ahead.

We use local riders, born and raised in Ha Giang, many of them from towns and villages throughout the loop. All of our drivers are licensed for fully manual bikes.

Because our riders are local, they know the roads, traffic rules and potential hazards, so you can relax - you're in safe hands!





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Self Riding Option

Legally, to ride in Vietnam (motorcycles above 50cc.) you require a motorcycle license in your home country and a valid International Driving License (IDP), Vietnam has only signed and ratified the 1968 Vienna Road Traffic convention. In addition Vietnam honors all ASEAN country licenses.

The International Driving License and 1949 Geneva version are not legally accepted in Vietnam.

Good news!!

We have a fleet of tuned 50cc semi-automatic bikes, allowing you to self ride, with no license required and no stress. (single riders only - no passenger)

More good news!!

If you are fully licensed with the correct IDP, we have a full range of manual bikes - from the very capable Honda XR150 through to the full adventure Honda CB500X



General Information



Spring (March and April) is cool/mild and dry but very short, May, **Summer** arrives - daily temps in the high 30's, rainy season is June through to early September, most rainfall happens at night after a very hot day, however, you can also experience random downpours, short but heavy. **Autumn** (October and November) is again mild/cool, dry and short. The **Winter** months of Dec, Jan and Feb are dry but can be very very cold up in the mountains, morning frost is not rare in Jan/Feb.

Packing list:

All year round: rain gear, a light **waterproof jacket** for the summer months is ample. **Decent footwear** for riding, trekking. The sun is very strong and so long sleeve tops and trousers are great to stop sunburn, if you love the sun, **factor 50** still ensures you'll get a tan! **Swimwear** and a **travel towel** for a river dip and waterfalls. For Spring and Autumn you may need a fleece or **hoodie** as it can feel a little cool. Winter you will need full clothing, proper **jackets, multiple layers, gloves, scarfs** etc... it can be seriously cold on a motorbike during winter... usually dry but cold! All our accommodations provide you with **towels and basic toiletries**.

Misc:

There's very good **MOBILE 4G** almost everywhere throughout the region, every homestay, café and restaurant also has **free Wi-Fi**. There are **ATMs** in most towns, these all charge a fee, **Agribank** is the cheapest at around 1 usd (25k vnd). Usually limited to 3m vnd per withdrawal. Hanoi and other large cities are much better. **VPbank** is currently fee free for foreign cards.



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
